STUDENT CIRCUMSTANCES REQUIRED FOR POSSIBLE FREE TUITION	
EARNING THRESHOLD	STUDYING A QUALIFICATION AT CHOSEN LEVEL, HAVING NOT ALREADY ACHIEVED ONE BEFOREHAND
The government has introduced the earnings threshold as part of a new eligibility criteria that enables learners to be fully funded if they earn below £35,000. The policy entitlement includes learners who are unemployed, employed or self-employed. We will need to see evidence of the your gross annual wages in these circumstances. This could be a wage slip or a Universal Credits statement, within 3 months of the learner's learning start date, or a current employment contract which states gross monthly/annual wages.	When enrolling, if the course you are joining will be the first time you have attained a qualification at this level, then (for eligible qualifications only) it is possible to have this funded for you, with no fees to pay.

* Some courses are defined as full cost and as such do not qualify for free tuition. Other courses are also not eligible for adult funding.

All of the above information applies to students who have resided in the UK/EEA for the past 3 years and are eligible for home funding.
